- ensure injured employees receive prompt medical attention and the necessary rehabilitation to work;
- monitor and measure health and safety performance and analyse causes of incidents and accidents;
- review and report incidents, accidents and injuries and follow-up with investigation and resolution of each;
- communicate and consult employees and others concerned (e.g. community, customers and suppliers) on this policy, health and safety matters and their individual responsibilities.

Management will regularly review health and safety processes and performance, and identify and implement required corrective and preventive action, within an overall philosophy of continuous improvement.
